

**FAIRFIELD COUNTY RURAL FIRE BOARD  
STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINES**

**SUBJECT: SOG FORMAT AND CONTROL**

The activities of the fire departments under jurisdiction of the Fairfield County Rural Fire Board will be controlled by written standard operating guidelines.

**GUIDELINES:** The following guidelines establish the format and means of controlling the Fairfield County Rural Fire Board SOG's.

1. This page represents the format of all SOG's.
2. The SOG will be assigned a number as shown in the upper right corner of this page (example: SOG-001, SOG-002, etc.) and referred to as SOG's. The fire marshal's office will maintain a master copy of all the SOG's and revisions.
3. Individual stations may issue their own SOG's as long as they do not conflict with the Fairfield County Fire Board's SOG's.
4. All fire service personnel and EMS personnel that respond as firefighters are responsible for being familiar with the SOG's.
5. The chief of each station or the EMS director will issue copies of the SOG's to each member of the department/EMS in hard copy or CD form.
