- c. PowerPoint Presentation: Multi-County Industrial Parks.
 - The SC Constitution allows for contiguous counties to jointly develop Industrial and Business Parks
 - "Multi-County" Park statutes were originally created to allow contiguous counties to share the cost of developing industrial and business parks and split the resulting revenues
 - In practice, most Multi-County Parks are created to provide access to additional incentives to qualified projects
 - Inclusion in a Multi-County Park provides access to the following incentives for the qualified business/industry: Additional \$1,000 per new job created for statutory State Jobs Tax Credit; Ability for the local government to negotiate a Special Source Revenue Credit on fee-in-lieu of tax payments (FILOT)
 - Fairfield has Multi-County Industrial Park Agreements with 3 contiguous counties: (Richland) Designated properties: Walter Brown I & II, Elite ES, Guardian Fiberglass, Infinity Foods, Carolina Adventure World; (Newberry) Designated property: McMaster property at Salem Crossroads; (Kershaw) Designated properties: Charm Building and Waters Property
 - Multi-County Industrial Revenues & Expenses (Cumulative Multi-County Park Payments By county: 2006-2010
- d. Video Presentation: Vision 2020 Plan.
- e. Update of the review of the County Council bylaws and board and commissions bylaws.
