**8. COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT AND CORRESPONDENCE****a.** Mr. Anderson made the following report:

- (1) Lake Wateree and Blair Recycling Centers Update
- (2) On schedule to open the old Cathcart Building. Waiting on signage for the building and floors to be buffed. Anticipating a July 15<sup>th</sup> date for the building to be furnished. Will be taking the old building down.
- (3) The HON building has been painted. Will be doing some renovations inside. Talked about doing an EMS main station.
- (4) Every county-owned fire station will be freshly painted.
- (5) Breaking ground on the chipping facility.
- (6) CTC Road List will be distributed to all members of Council.

**b.** Behavioral Health Services Letter of Support.Comments:

- o BHS primarily applying for a grant. Made it clear that the County is not in the loan-repaying business.
- o Concerns with the statement that read "...the only organization in our county that we have designated to be the sole authority for alcohol and drug abuse services..."
- o The wording submitted for consideration of approval by the Council does not allow any other agency to come in and provide certain services.
- o Would like to see the letter constructed to read "they are the designated agency of the county"... rather than "sole authority".
- o Make sure this fits in with the State plan for this organization.
- o The county is endorsing it only if it is for a grant.
- o Do they own the building they are in? Would they be selling it or leasing it?
- o *It was moved by Council Member Brown; seconded by Vice Chairman Perry to approve the letter of support, with the changes as outlined by County Council. The motion carried 6-1. {Council Member Marcharia voted nay}.*
