Increase the number of housing options for senior citizens and individuals with disabilities.		
Encourage the development of walkable neighborhoods that prioritize pedestrian safety and accessibility.		
Encourage a mixture of compatible housing types such as ADU's, Duplex, Townhouse, Triplex, etc.		
Redevelop existing vacant lots and deteriorated housing stock.		
Promote the preservation and restoration of historic homes and buildings in the community.
